Required courses include: VMS 202D (Introduction to Visual Culture), VMS 327S (Theories of Visual and Media Studies), and an upper-level seminar drawn from a curated list of approved courses published each semester. The ten (10) remaining courses must be distributed as follows: at least two (2) courses in visual & media history and/or art history; at least two (2) courses in visual & media practice; at least three (3) additional courses taught by AAHVS faculty; and up to three (3) previously-approved cross-listed electives (which may be taught by non-AAHVS faculty). A maximum of two (2) courses taken away from Duke will count toward the major.
